



## Investment Objective & Strategy

The aim of the VIP Conservative eXplore Portfolio is to provide investors with a reliable income stream with the potential for moderate capital growth over the medium to long term through exposure to a diversified portfolio of ETF's tracking major indices, while providing low management costs to investors. The investments have a heavy weight to defensive assets and holding some growth assets to provide the desired investment risk profile and returns. The portfolio is composed of exposure to asset class indices, following prices movements of Australian Shares, Listed Investment Companies (LICs), Government and Semi-Government Bonds, Corporate Bonds, Term Deposits and Cash. A targeted tactical allocation is employed by Value Investment Partners in order to maximise investor wealth and mitigate volatility.

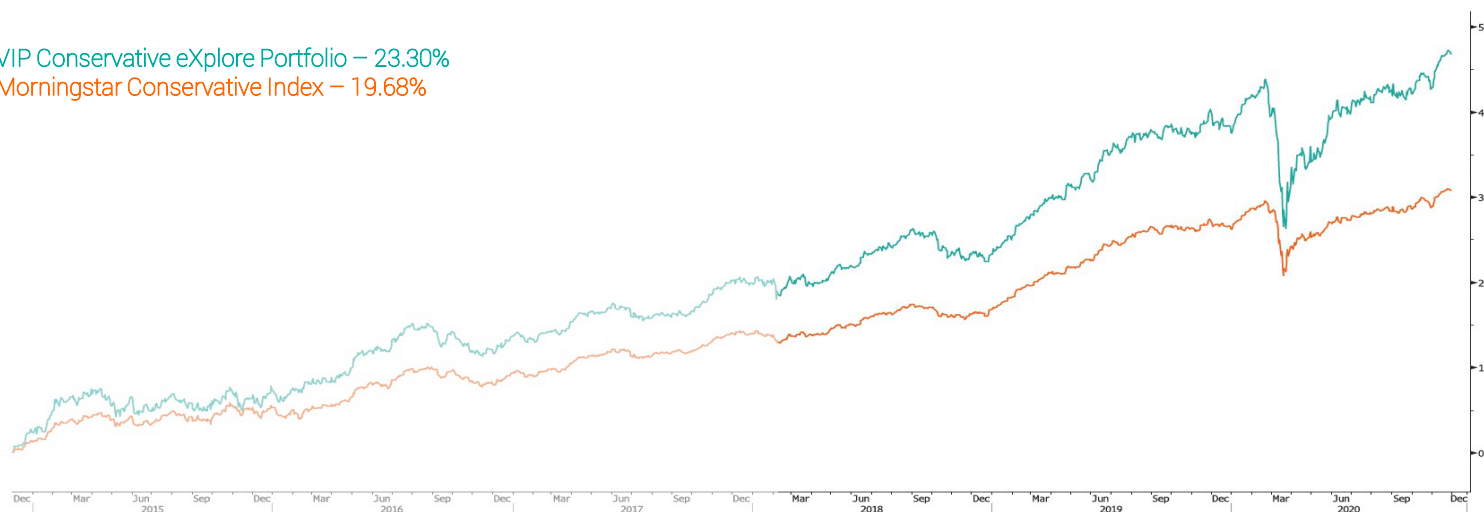

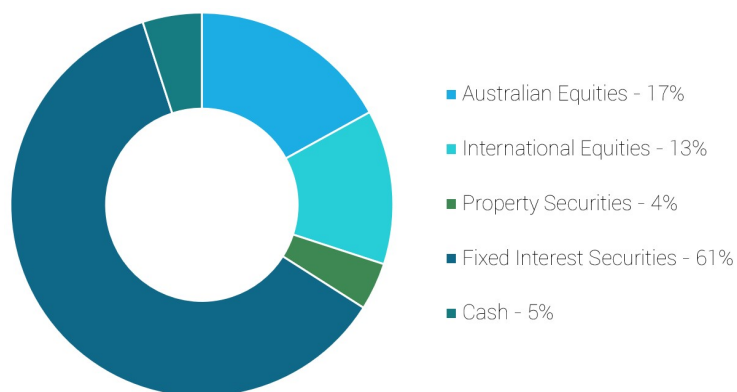
